

STANDARDS FOR OTHER CROPS

In addition to the standards listed in this book, Colorado Seed Growers Association has also approved a set of standards for each of the following additional crops: Cicer Milkvetch, Clover, Corn, Cross-pollinated (Pearl) Millet, Hybrid Small Grains, Hybrid Sorghum, Sorghum, and Hybrid Sunflowers. The Association of Official Seed Certifying Agencies maintains minimum standards for all crops Certified. In the event that certification is requested for a crop for which Colorado certification standards will be used or Colorado certification standards are not listed in this handbook, AOSCA standards will be used or Colorado certification standards will be developed providing a request for certification standards is submitted to the Colorado Seed Growers Association by April 1 of the year certification is requested.
